QUESTIONS & ANSWERS ABOUT TAX CREDITS

Q. Who may claim these tax credits? A. These credits are available only to individuals or couples who pay Arizona State Taxes and make cash contributions to a public/charter and/or private schools.
Q. Can a taxpayer claim both credits in the same taxable year? A. Yes. A taxpayer can claim both the public school tax credit (\$200 single - \$400 if married), and the private school tuition scholarships (\$500 single - \$1000 if married).
Q. Must a taxpayer have a child in school in order to claim one or both of these credits? A. No. Any Arizona taxpayer can contribute to any school.
Q. What does your money support when you contribute to a public/charter school? A. The contributions support Extracurricular Activities or Character Education Programs.
Q. What does your money support when you contribute to a private school tuition fund? A. The cash donations go to scholarships/grants for approved students.
